Dear Pesticide Registrant,

Over the last few decades, the Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA) has provided cursory reviews on all pesticide product label revisions. Effective January 1, 2022, MDA will be thoroughly reviewing all revised pesticide labels with the current registered label to determine if there are significant changes. These would include, but are not limited to:

- Changes to Directions for Use
- Changes to Storage and Disposal
- Changes to PPE
- Change in percentage of active ingredient
- Alternate brand name products
- Change in brand name of registered product
- Change in company name or address on the label
- Changing amounts of N, P, and K in weed and feed products

If a significant change is identified, then a new registration will be required and the \$200 product registration fee must be paid before the pesticide enters the channels of trade in Missouri. As a reminder, all pesticides must remain registered as long as they are in the channels of trade in Missouri. For example, if a revised label is submitted and requires a new registration, as long as the "older label" remains in the channels of trade, it too must remain registered in Missouri.

Staff will confirm receipt of the email and once the revised label has been reviewed, you will receive an email informing you if a new registration is needed or not.
